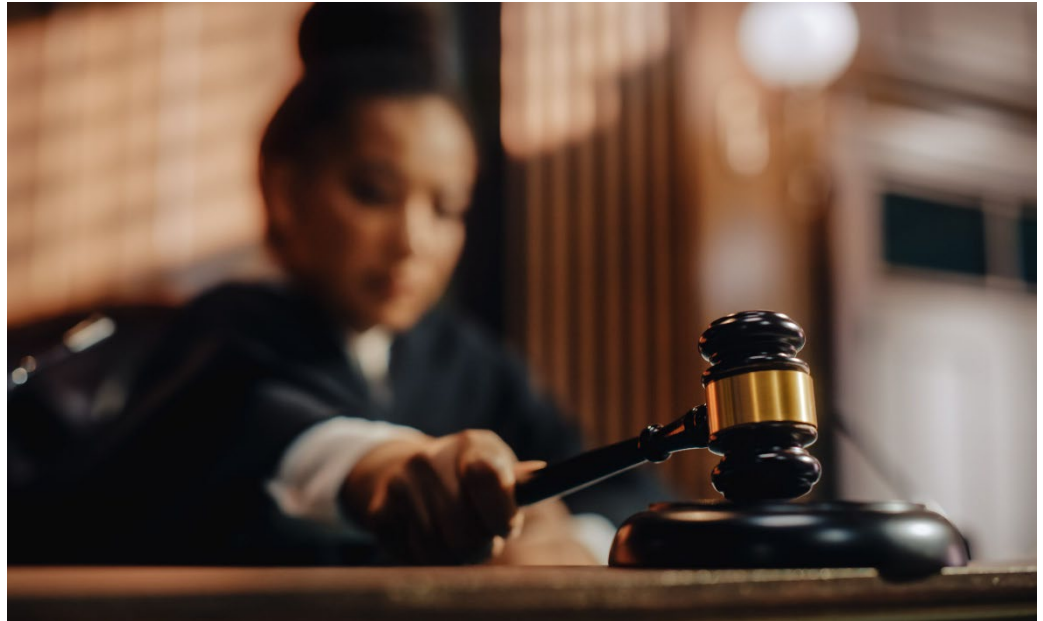

To assist in the court's recruitment and training of temporary judges, the court will be providing the required in-person Bench Conduct and Demeanor Training on Friday, September 30, from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm, at the Watsonville Courthouse Jury Assembly Room. There is no cost to participate.
